Sun Cream...summer shoes and hats!

Now that the weather is becoming warmer they children will need to bring a **named tube of factor 50 sun cream** into nursery for the staff to apply throughout the day. Please would you apply sun cream to you child before you drop them off to nursery, and we will apply it regularly throughout the day.

All the nursery children will need a **named summer hat** to wear in nursery, please.

The safety of the children is our top priority. **We do not allow children to come into nursery who are wearing 'cros' or open toed summer sandals.**

This is because the children are very active in the garden especially during the summer months, climbing, running, jumping etc and need to be wearing shoes that fit securely around their feet.
